Introduction

On Wednesday 2nd November 2022, the Office for National Statistics (ONS) published its second phase outputs from the 2021 Census, which provides statistics on migration for all Local Authority areas in England & Wales.

The 2021 Census estimates the total number of Barnet's population born in the United Kingdom to be 221,293 which makes up 56.8% of the total population of Barnet. In the 2011 Census, 217,890 were born in the United Kingdom and was 61.1% of the total population. The summary key points are:

- Those born in the United Kingdom that reside in Barnet in 2021 fell by -4.3% vs Census 2011.
- Countries of birth that had the highest increase include Romania at a 200% increase and Iran with a 55% increase from 2011 to 2021.
- Countries and regions that saw the largest decrease include, Ireland, Poland and Southern and South-East Asia.
- The number of those residents who do not hold a passport fell from 19,813 in 2011 to 16,789 which is a reduction of -1.3%.
- Those aged 25 to 59 arriving in the United Kingdom and residing in Barnet in 2021 have seen an increase, especially in the 30 to 44 age range.
- Those that have resided in the United Kingdom for 10 years or more make up 26.9% of Barnet's total population. This is an increase of 5.3% since the 2011 Census.



Country of Birth

The Census 2011 used different categorisations relating to European Union membership and other Non-EU counties, so statistics are not currently comparable with the current census tables released by the Office of National Statistics (ONS).

EU14 are countries who were members of the EU prior to 2004: Austria, Belgium, Denmark, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Republic of Ireland, Italy, Luxembourg, the Netherlands, Portugal, Spain and Sweden.

EU8 are countries who joined the EU January 2004: Czech Republic, Estonia, Hungary, Latvia, Lithuania, Poland, Slovakia, Slovenia.

EU2 is Bulgaria and Romania, who joined the EU in January 2007.

Non-EU is all other countries outside of the UK, with the exception of Cyprus, Malta and Croatia, which are known as EU Other.



The number of Barnet residents who were born in the United Kingdom increased by 3,403 from 217,890 in 2011 to 221,293 in 2021 which is an increase of 1.6%. Those who were born outside of the UK increased from 138,496 in 2011 to 168,050 which is an increase of 21.3%.

Those born in the Middle East and Asia make up 15.3% of Barnet's population which is 2.3% more than the London average of 13%.


Residents born in England make up the majority of Barnet's population, however, there have been increases since 2011 in people residing in Barnet that were born in certain countries. There has been a 200% increase since 2011 of those born in Romania now living in Barnet and a 55% increase of those born in Iran now residing in Barnet.

Chart 1: Countries of Birth with the highest numerical increase in population in Barnet from 2011 Census to 2021 Census



Some populations of residents born outside of Barnet have seen a decrease in their total since the 2011 Census. Due to the way Census information is collected, it groups certain countries together into regions as the individual county numbers are too small. South Asian and South-East Asian regions had the largest numerical decrease in population from Census 2011 to Census 2021 and the countries of Ireland and Poland had the largest numerical decreases in Barnet from Census 2011 to Census 2022.

Passports Held

Although the total number of those holding United Kingdom passports has increased, the absolute percent of those that hold a passport in 2021 has dropped by -1.5% vs 2011 census but this is reflective of the demographic changes over the previous 10 years in Barnet. The number of those residents who do not hold a passport fell from 19,813 in 2011 to 16,789 which is a reduction of -1.3%.

Age of Arrival in the UK

Age of arrival in the United Kingdom for residents not born in the UK living in Barnet in 2021 from the ages of 0 to 24 have seen a slight decrease as a total percent of the population since 2011. Those aged 25 to 59 have seen an increase, especially in the 30 to 44 age range.



Chart 2: Percentage of Age of Arrival in the UK (excluding Born in UK) Census 2021



Length of Residence in the UK

In the 2021 Census, those that have resided in the United Kingdom for 10 years or more made up 26.9% of Barnet's total population. This is an increase of 5.3% since the 2011 Census and is also 2.6% more than the 2021 London average. Other length of residence categories excluding those that were born in the UK have broadly remained the same.
