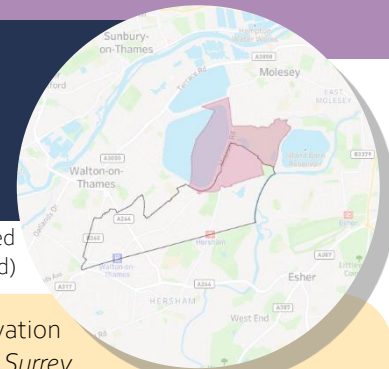
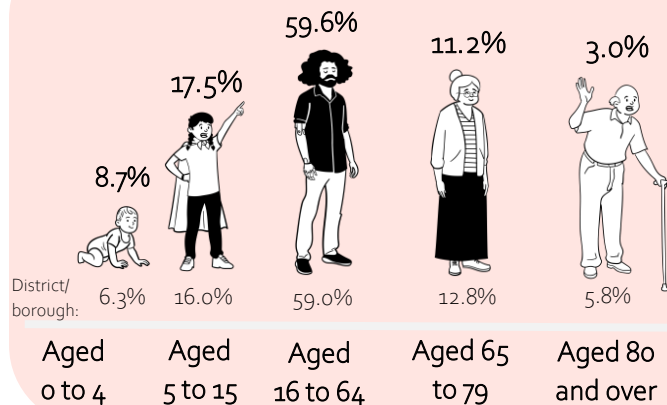


# 'Elmbridge 004B' in Walton South

1384 residents (2020)



6.1% receive jobseekers' allowance or universal credit (2.0% in D/B) (July 2022)

16.3% of all children are in absolute low income families (5.5% in D/B, 7.7% in Surrey, 15.4% in England) (2020/21)

36.9% of which are in lone parent families. 16.9% of which are in out of work families.

16.2% pensioners are in poverty (6.5% in D/B, 6.0% in Surrey) (February 2022)

10.1% of households were in fuel poverty in 2020, which is likely to have risen considerably (6.1% in D/B)

6.7% households not connected to the gas network (9.7% in D/B) (2020)

(2021) 20.2% lower carbon footprint per person than the D/B average (21.7% higher than England)

**108.4 overall crime offences per 1,000 people** (69.8 in D/B, 74.3 in Surrey, 94.3 in England)

- 23.1 anti-social behaviour (13.3 in D/B)
- 8.0 burglary (9.5 in D/B)
- 42.6 violent crime and sexual offences (21.9 in D/B)
- 0.0 robbery (0.3 in D/B)
- 5.1 vehicle crime (4.3 in D/B)
- 15.2 criminal damage (6.1 in D/B)

The 3 sectors with the most jobs in the area (2020):

- 26.7% in transport and storage (inc postal),
- 20.0% in construction,
- 13.3% in business administration and support services.

26.8% of all adults have no qualifications (13.2% D/B, & 19.2% of those aged 16-24 (11.0% D/B). (2011 Census)

**Estimated disease prevalence** (2019/20)

- 12.7% high blood pressure (11.7% D/B, 13.3% Surrey)
- 9.0% depression (9.3% D/B, 10.4% Surrey)
- 6.3% obesity (6.0% D/B, 7.4% Surrey)
- 5.8% diabetes (4.6% D/B, 5.8% Surrey)
- 4.9% asthma (5.2% D/B, 5.9% Surrey)
- 101.2% cancer - number of new cases as % of expected new cases - (95.8% D/B, 97.4% Surrey)

6.4% of residents do not have English as their main language
