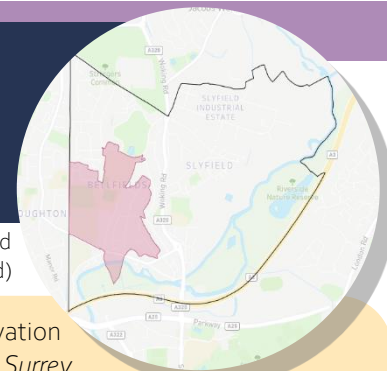
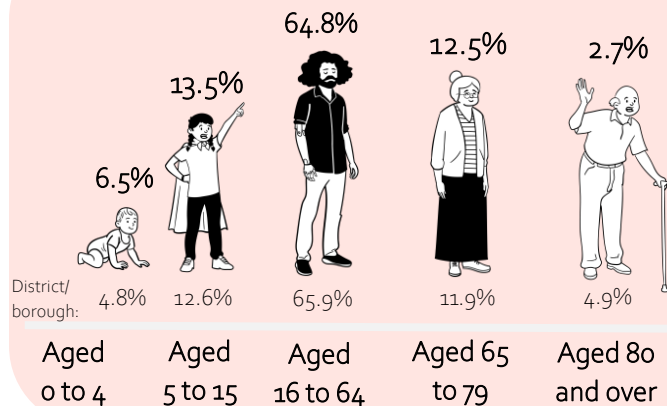


# 'Guildford 007C' in Stoke

1478 residents (2020)



4.7% receive jobseekers' allowance or universal credit (1.7% in D/B) (July 2022)

12.7% of all children are in absolute low income families (6.4% in D/B, 7.7% in Surrey, 15.4% in England) (2020/21)

12.8% of which are in lone parent families. 23.4% of which are in out of work families.

23.6% pensioners are in poverty (5.8% in D/B, 6.0% in Surrey) (February 2022)

15.1% of households were in fuel poverty in 2020, which is likely to have risen considerably (7.9% in D/B)

1.6% households not connected to the gas network (12.3% in D/B) (2020)

(2021) 4.6% lower carbon footprint per person than the D/B average (27.3% lower than England)

**82.5 overall crime offences per 1,000 people** (77.2 in D/B, 74.3 in Surrey, 94.3 in England)

Per 1,000 (Jun-21 to May-22):

- 16.2 anti-social behaviour (15.7 in D/B)
- 1.6 burglary (6.1 in D/B)
- 39.9 violent crime and sexual offences (24.9 in D/B)
- 0.0 robbery (0.3 in D/B)
- 0.7 vehicle crime (3.3 in D/B)
- 3.4 criminal damage (6.2 in D/B)

Index of Multiple Deprivation (IMD, 2019) ranks *within Surrey* (out of 709): *1st = most deprived*

The 3 sectors with the most jobs in the area (2020):

- 83.3% in education,
- 6.7% in public administration and defence,
- 3.3% in construction.

39.7% of all adults have no qualifications (14.2% D/B, & 17.8% of those aged 16-24 (6.4% D/B). (2011 Census)

- 10.5% high blood pressure (12.4% D/B, 13.3% Surrey)
- 12.5% depression (10.7% D/B, 10.4% Surrey)
- 6.6% obesity (7.0% D/B, 7.4% Surrey)
- 4.6% diabetes (5.0% D/B, 5.8% Surrey)
- 5.9% asthma (6.2% D/B, 5.9% Surrey)
- 105.9% cancer - number of new cases as % of expected new cases - (95.8% D/B, 97.4% Surrey)

6.4% of residents do not have English as their main language
