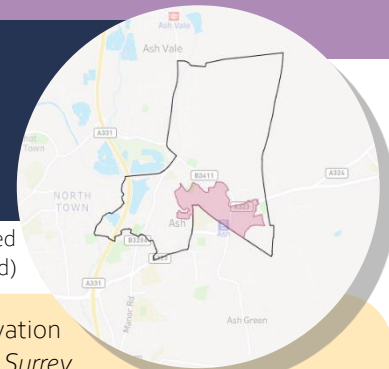
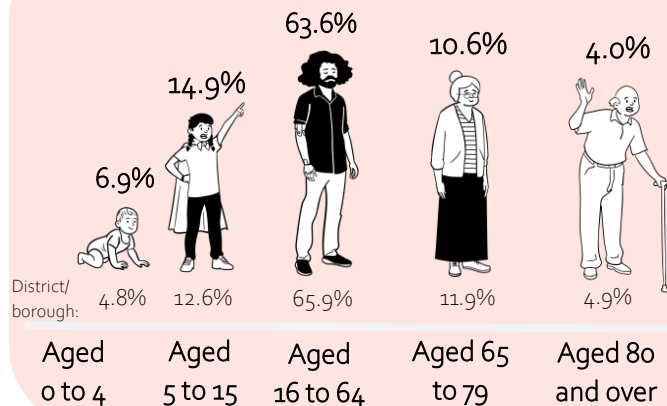


'Guildford 010C' in Ash Wharf

1535 residents (2020)



3.1% receive jobseekers' allowance or universal credit (1.7% in D/B) (July 2022)

14.6% of all children are in absolute low income families (6.4% in D/B, 7.7% in Surrey, 15.4% in England) (2020/21)

37.1% of which are in lone parent families. 14.5% of which are in out of work families.

13.8% pensioners are in poverty (5.8% in D/B, 6.0% in Surrey) (February 2022)

9.5% of households were in fuel poverty in 2020, which is likely to have risen considerably (7.9% in D/B)

7.7% households not connected to the gas network (12.3% in D/B) (2020)

(2021) 18.8% lower carbon footprint per person than the D/B average (10.4% higher than England)

78.2 overall crime offences per 1,000 people (77.2 in D/B, 74.3 in Surrey, 94.3 in England)

- 20.8 anti-social behaviour (15.7 in D/B)
- 6.2 burglary (6.1 in D/B)

The 3 sectors with the most jobs in the area (2020):

- 20.0% in construction,
- 20.0% in manufacturing,
- 10.0% in professional, scientific and technical.

27.0% of all adults have no qualifications (14.2% D/B, & 15.1% of those aged 16-24 (6.4% D/B). (2011 Census)

- 15.3% high blood pressure (12.4% D/B, 13.3% Surrey)
- 10.7% depression (10.7% D/B, 10.4% Surrey)
- 9.5% obesity (7.0% D/B, 7.4% Surrey)
- 7.1% diabetes (5.0% D/B, 5.8% Surrey)
- 6.8% asthma (6.2% D/B, 5.9% Surrey)
- 113.0% cancer - number of new cases as % of expected new cases - (95.8% D/B, 97.4% Surrey)
