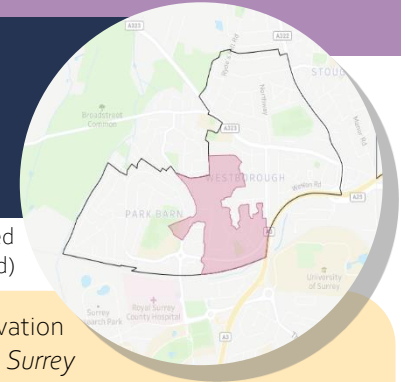
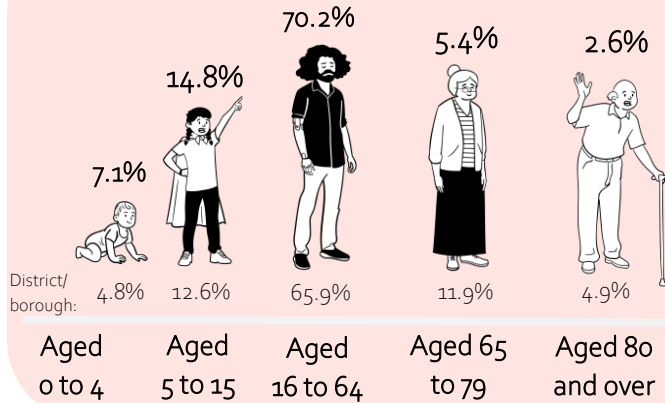


'Guildford 012D' in Westborough

1767 residents (2020)



3.6% receive jobseekers' allowance or universal credit (1.7% in D/B) (July 2022)

19.1% of all children are in absolute low income families (6.4% in D/B, 7.7% in Surrey, 15.4% in England) (2020/21)

50.0% of which are in lone parent families. 29.3% of which are in out of work families.

14.2% pensioners are in poverty (5.8% in D/B, 6.0% in Surrey) (February 2022)

21.3% of households were in fuel poverty in 2020, which is likely to have risen considerably (7.9% in D/B)

4.8% households not connected to the gas network (12.3% in D/B) (2020)

(2021) 58.8% lower carbon footprint per person than the D/B average (43.9% lower than England)

95.6 overall crime offences per 1,000 people (77.2 in D/B, 74.3 in Surrey, 94.3 in England)

Per 1,000 (Jun-21 to May-22):

- 22.1 anti-social behaviour (15.7 in D/B)
- 4.8 burglary (6.1 in D/B)
- 42.4 violent crime and sexual offences (24.9 in D/B)
- 0.6 robbery (0.3 in D/B)
- 3.4 vehicle crime (3.3 in D/B)
- 5.7 criminal damage (6.2 in D/B)

- 407th Living Environment.

The 3 sectors with the most jobs in the area (2020):

- 25.0% in health,
- 12.5% in construction,
- 12.5% in arts, entertainment, recreation and other services.

25.6% of all adults have no qualifications (14.2% D/B, & 16.2% of those aged 16-24 (6.4% D/B). (2011 Census)

Estimated disease prevalence (2019/20)

- 10.1% high blood pressure (12.4% D/B, 13.3% Surrey)
- 12.3% depression (10.7% D/B, 10.4% Surrey)
- 6.6% obesity (7.0% D/B, 7.4% Surrey)
- 4.5% diabetes (5.0% D/B, 5.8% Surrey)
- 5.8% asthma (6.2% D/B, 5.9% Surrey)
- 115.9% cancer - number of new cases as % of expected new cases - (95.8% D/B, 97.4% Surrey)

11.2% of residents do not have English as their main language
