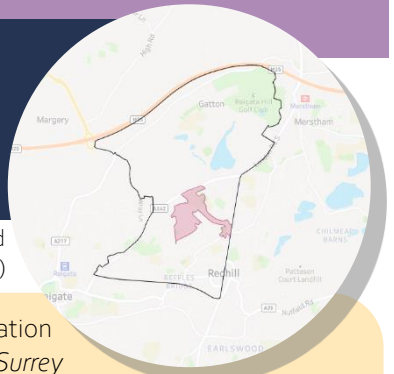
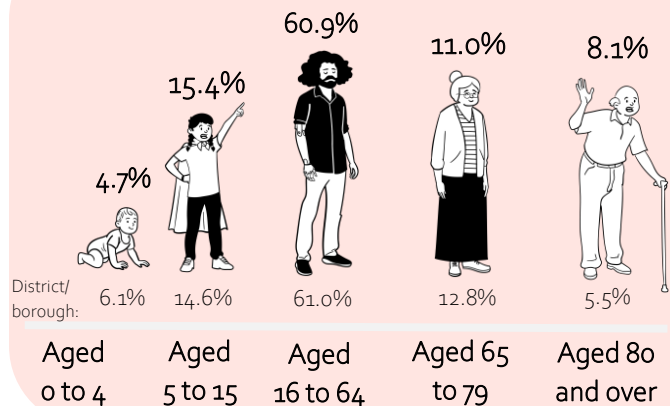


'Reigate and Banstead 010E' in Redhill West & Wray Common



1503 residents (2020)



3.8% receive jobseekers' allowance or universal credit (2.1% in D/B) (July 2022)

18.6% of all children are in absolute low income families (8.8% in D/B, 7.7% in Surrey, 15.4% in England) (2020/21)

46.3% of which are in lone parent families. 17.9% of which are in out of work families.

15.7% pensioners are in poverty (5.9% in D/B, 6.0% in Surrey) (February 2022)

8.7% of households were in fuel poverty in 2020, which is likely to have risen considerably (6.9% in D/B)

6.3% households not connected to the gas network (8.3% in D/B) (2020)

(2021) 47.4% lower carbon footprint per person than the D/B average (28.1% lower than England)

89.8 overall crime offences per 1,000 people (71.3 in D/B, 74.3 in Surrey, 94.3 in England)

Per 1,000 (Jun-21 to May-22):

- 6.7 anti-social behaviour (13.6 in D/B)
- 11.2 burglary (5.9 in D/B)
- 41.3 violent crime and sexual offences (25.3 in D/B)
- 1.3 robbery (0.3 in D/B)
- 7.3 vehicle crime (4.6 in D/B)
- 7.3 criminal damage (5.9 in D/B)

The 3 sectors with the most jobs in the area (2020):

- 57.1% in education,
- 14.3% in transport and storage (inc postal),
- 10.0% in health.

25.5% of all adults have no qualifications (16.6% D/B, & 13.1% of those aged 16-24 (10.8% D/B). (2011 Census)

- 12.8% high blood pressure (13.2% D/B, 13.3% Surrey)
- 11.3% depression (10.7% D/B, 10.4% Surrey)
- 8.4% obesity (8.0% D/B, 7.4% Surrey)
- 6.2% diabetes (6.1% D/B, 5.8% Surrey)
- 6.6% asthma (6.3% D/B, 5.9% Surrey)
- 92.6% cancer - number of new cases as % of expected new cases - (100.7% D/B, 97.4% Surrey)

9.6% of residents do not have English as their main language
