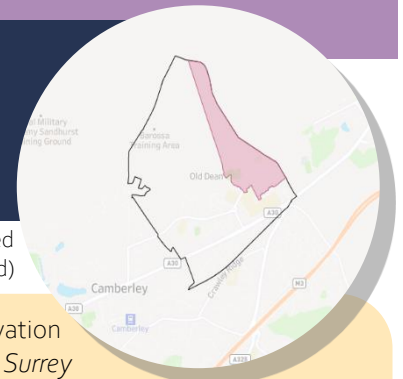
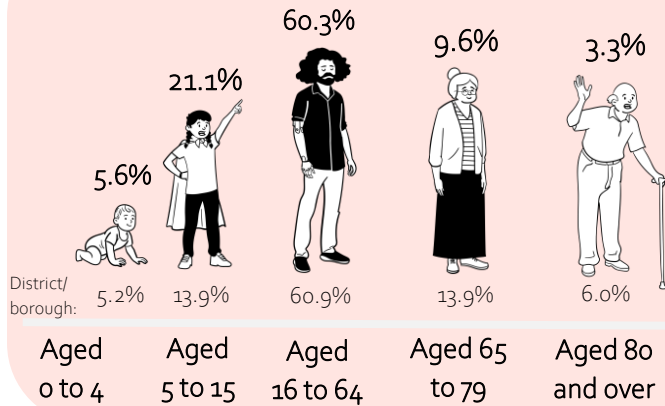


# 'Surrey Heath 004C' in Old Dean

1440 residents (2020)



3.5% receive jobseekers' allowance or universal credit (2.0% in D/B) (July 2022)

15.3% of all children are in absolute low income families (7.8% in D/B, 7.7% in Surrey, 15.4% in England) (2020/21)

54.3% of which are in lone parent families. 21.4% of which are in out of work families.

18.8% pensioners are in poverty (5.3% in D/B, 6.0% in Surrey) (February 2022)

15.2% of households were in fuel poverty in 2020, which is likely to have risen considerably (5.8% in D/B)

2.0% households not connected to the gas network (7.6% in D/B) (2020)

(2021) 45.3% lower carbon footprint per person than the D/B average (16.1% lower than England)

**99.3 overall crime offences per 1,000 people** (66.6 in D/B, 74.3 in Surrey, 94.3 in England)

- 40.0% in education,
- 20.0% in construction,
- 13.3% in transport and storage (inc postal).

30.2% of all adults have no qualifications (15.0% D/B, & 22.6% of those aged 16-24 (9.2% D/B). (2011 Census)

- 14.6% high blood pressure (14.0% D/B, 13.3% Surrey)
- 10.3% depression (9.2% D/B, 10.4% Surrey)
- 7.9% obesity (8.0% D/B, 7.4% Surrey)
- 6.4% diabetes (6.0% D/B, 5.8% Surrey)
- 6.3% asthma (6.1% D/B, 5.9% Surrey)
- 97.2% cancer - number of new cases as % of expected new cases - (96.0% D/B, 97.4% Surrey)
