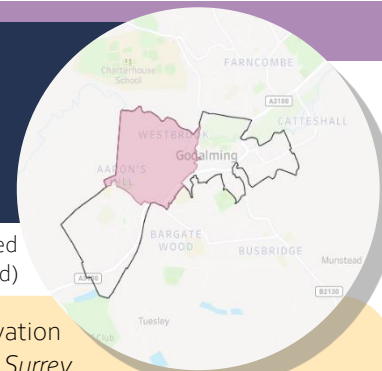
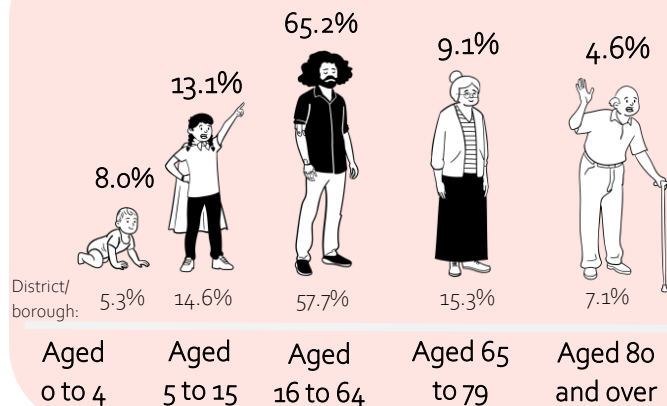


# 'Waverley 010A' in Godalming Central and Ockford

1387 residents (2020)



3.3% receive jobseekers' allowance or universal credit (1.7% in D/B) (July 2022)

8.0% of all children are in absolute low income families (6.6% in D/B, 7.7% in Surrey, 15.4% in England) (2020/21)

37.0% of which are in lone parent families. 18.5% of which are in out of work families.

11.6% pensioners are in poverty (5.4% in D/B, 6.0% in Surrey) (February 2022)

7.1% of households were in fuel poverty in 2020, which is likely to have risen considerably (7.3% in D/B)

0.0% households not connected to the gas network (11.9% in D/B) (2020)

(2021) 41.1% lower carbon footprint per person than the D/B average (10.1% lower than England)

**135.5 overall crime offences per 1,000 people** (54.7 in D/B, 74.3 in Surrey, 94.3 in England)

Per 1,000 (Jun-21 to May-22):

- 51.2 anti-social behaviour (10.6 in D/B)
- 3.7 burglary (8.1 in D/B)
- 36.8 violent crime and sexual offences (17.1 in D/B)
- 0.0 robbery (0.2 in D/B)
- 5.8 vehicle crime (3.3 in D/B)
- 12.3 criminal damage (4.9 in D/B)

The 3 sectors with the most jobs in the area (2020):

- 28.6% in business administration and support services,
- 17.1% in health,
- 14.3% in professional, scientific and technical.

26.1% of all adults have no qualifications (15.2% D/B), & 21.5% of those aged 16-24 (8.7% D/B). (2011 Census)

**Estimated disease prevalence** (2019/20)

- 12.2% high blood pressure (14.2% D/B, 13.3% Surrey)
- 10.6% depression (11.5% D/B, 10.4% Surrey)
- 5.5% obesity (7.0% D/B, 7.4% Surrey)
- 5.2% diabetes (5.4% D/B, 5.8% Surrey)
- 6.2% asthma (6.4% D/B, 5.9% Surrey)
- 95.6% cancer - number of new cases as % of expected new cases - (93.3% D/B, 97.4% Surrey)

2.8% of residents do not have English as their main language
