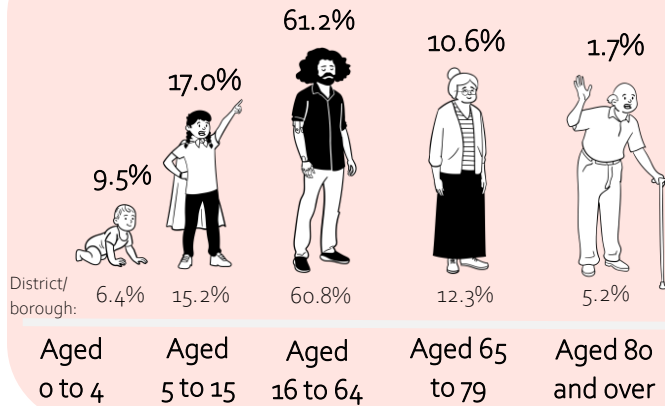


'Woking 004F' in Canalside



1215 residents (2020)



4.7% receive jobseekers' allowance or universal credit (2.5% in D/B) (July 2022)

32.7% of all children are in absolute low income families (10.4% in D/B, 7.7% in Surrey, 15.4% in England) (2020/21)

28.7% of which are in lone parent families. 32.6% of which are in out of work families.

18.7% pensioners are in poverty (6.9% in D/B, 6.0% in Surrey) (February 2022)

13.3% of households were in fuel poverty in 2020, which is likely to have risen considerably (6.5% in D/B)

12.7% households not connected to the gas network (16.4% in D/B) (2020)

(2021) 56.3% lower carbon footprint per person than the D/B average (36.4% lower than England)

112.8 overall crime offences per 1,000 people (83.7 in D/B, 74.3 in Surrey, 94.3 in England)

Per 1,000 (Jun-21 to May-22):

- 30.5 anti-social behaviour (17.3 in D/B)
- 6.2 burglary (7.1 in D/B)
- 32.1 violent crime and sexual offences (28.2 in D/B)
- 0.8 robbery (0.5 in D/B)
- 7.4 vehicle crime (3.7 in D/B)
- 9.1 criminal damage (6.2 in D/B)

Index of Multiple Deprivation (IMD, 2019) ranks *within Surrey* (out of 709):

1st = most deprived

2nd Overall Deprivation.
4th Income.
2nd Employment.
16th Education, Skills & Training.

10th Health & Disability.
11th Crime.
270th Barriers to Housing & Services.
578th Living Environment.

The 3 sectors with the most jobs in the area (2020):
66.7% in information and communication,
8.9% in education,
4.4% in business administration and support services.

30.1% of all adults have no qualifications (15.2% D/B, & 16.7% of those aged 16-24 (8.8% D/B). (2011 Census)

- 10.1% high blood pressure (11.9% D/B, 13.3% Surrey)
- 7.6% depression (9.2% D/B, 10.4% Surrey)
- 10.1% obesity (10.0% D/B, 7.4% Surrey)
- 8.2% diabetes (6.2% D/B, 5.8% Surrey)
- 5.4% asthma (5.6% D/B, 5.9% Surrey)
- 89.5% cancer - number of new cases as % of expected new cases - (98.1% D/B, 97.4% Surrey)

20.6% of residents do not have English as their main language
